

Spring Semester 2005 Registration/Academic Calendar (archived 3/1/05)

NOTE: Any student who completes registration agrees to pay the University of Colorado at Boulder all charges on your account when due. (See bursar.colorado.edu/now/tuitfeebill.html)

October 25-29 (Mon.-Fri.)	▶ Spring 2005 course reservation registration period for eligible students. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Course.htm)
November 1-28 (Mon.-Sun.)	▶ Spring 2005 registration time assignments for students enrolled during fall 2004. For best course selection, register as soon as possible after your time assignment begins. Continuing students can register through January 6.
November 29 (Mon.) – January 6 (Thurs.)	▶ Schedule adjustment for continuing degree students who have registered for spring semester and registration for continuing students who have not yet registered. ▶Spring 2005 registration for eligible new and readmitted students who have confirmed with admissions.
December 10 (Fri.)	Deadline to update your billing and permanent addresses to ensure that your spring 2005 bill is mailed to the correct address.
December 13 (Mon.)	Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register by December 10. If no billing address is on record, bills are mailed to the permanent address.
December 31 (Fri.)	▶ Deadline for continuing students to withdraw from the university and receive a full refund of the \$200 enrollment deposit, less any outstanding charges. (This deadline to withdraw and not forfeit the deposit also applies to students planning to go on the Time Out Program.) New and readmitted students are not eligible for a refund. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Support/Withdraw.htm)
January 4 (Tues.)	Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register December 11-31. If no billing address is on record, bills are mailed to the permanent address.
January 6 (Thurs.)	▶ Deadline (6:00 p.m.) for all students, both undergraduate and graduate, to register for spring courses. Registration must be completed by 6:00 p.m. on this day to be guaranteed enrollment for spring semester. After this date, registration is on a space-available basis, and a \$50 late fee is charged. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/add-reg/late.htm)
January 7 (Fri.)	▶ Drop/add time assignments begin. (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm) ▶ACCESS registration begins. (See www.colorado.edu/conted/access.htm) ▶Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register January 1-6.
January 9 (Sun.)	▶ Drop/add time assignments continue. (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm) ▶Faculty/staff registration begins.
January 10 (Mon.)	▶ Classes begin.
January 17 (Mon.)	Martin Luther King Jr. holiday. No classes. University closed.

January 18 (Tues.)	Space-available registration for Senior Citizens Auditors Program, Koenig Alumni Center, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; continues on Wednesday, January 19, 9:00 a.m. to noon. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/add-reg/senior.htm)
January 19 (Wed.)	<p>Add Deadline:</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add a course, including independent study and thesis, without the instructor's signature. <i>After this date, the instructor's signature is required on a special action form to add a course (through January 28).</i> NOTE: After 5:00 p.m. on this date, web registration is only available for dropping courses (through 5:00 p.m. on January 26, the drop deadline). (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm)</p> <p>Wait List Deadline:</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add name to a course wait list. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Waitlist.htm)</p> <p>Tuition Payment Deadlines:</p> <p>▶ Deadline to pay full tuition and fees (or first payment of two-payment plan). Due before 6:00 p.m. if paid in person or mailed, or before midnight using the E-check option. No grace period. (See bursar.colorado.edu/now/tuitfeebill.html)</p> <p>▶ Deadline to sign up for the two-payment plan before midnight via PLUS. No grace period.</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to select or waive university sponsored health insurance at Wardenburg Health Center.</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) for private scholarship checks to be received in the financial aid Scholarship Office to avoid late and service charges.</p>
January 26 (Wed.)	<p>Drop Deadline:</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to drop a course without the instructor's signature, without being assessed tuition and fees for that course, and without a <i>W</i> grade appearing on the transcript. <i>After this date, the instructor's signature is required on a special action form and students must be passing the course to drop it.</i> (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm.) <i>No refunds for tuition or fees are given for courses dropped after this date.</i></p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to petition to waive UCSU student fees.</p> <p>▶ Deadline to request a refund of any student opportunities fees you selected. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Student.htm)</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to withdraw from the university and only be assessed \$200 in tuition and fees. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Support/Withdraw.htm)</p>
January 28 (Fri.)	<p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add a course without petitioning your dean. NOTE: Instructors' signature is required on a special action form to add a course. In general, instructors only approve an add if students have been regularly attending and there's space in the course. (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm)</p> <p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to change variable-credit hours, pass/fail, and no-credit status on courses. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Support/creditandgradingoptions.htm)</p>
February 9 (Wed.)	<p>▶ Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to withdraw from the university and only be assessed 40 percent of full tuition and fees. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Waitlist.htm)</p>

February 18 (Fri.)	<p>► Deadline for students who have three or more final exams on the same day for spring semester to make arrangements to change their final exam schedule. (See http://registrar.colorado.edu/Calendar/examschedules.htm)</p>
February 23 (Wed.)	<p>► Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to drop a course without petitioning the dean's office. (See registrar.colorado.edu/DropAdd/Default.htm)</p> <p>► Deadline to pay unpaid balance (including two-payment plan). Due 5:00 p.m. if paid in person or mailed, or before midnight using the E-check option. No grace period.</p> <p>► Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to withdraw from the university and only be assessed 60 percent of full tuition and fees. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Waitlist.htm)</p> <p>► Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to turn in Time Out Program (TOP) applications to the registrar's office and be assured a continuing student registration time assignment for fall semester 2005. (See http://registrar.colorado.edu/Support/Timeout.htm)</p>
March 2 (Wed.)	<p>► Summer 2005 registration begins for continuing degree students enrolled during spring 2005.</p> <p>► Fall 2005 course listings available on the Web (tentative date).</p>
March 7 (Mon.)	Summer 2005 registration begins for eligible new and readmitted students and for nondegree students.
March 14-24 (Mon.-Thurs.)	Fall 2005 course reservation registration period for eligible students. (See registrar.colorado.edu/Registration/Course.htm)
March 21-25 (Mon.-Fri.)	Spring break. No classes. University closed on Friday.
March 28 (Mon.) – April 24 (Sun.)	Fall 2005 registration period for continuing degree students enrolled during spring 2005.
April 25 (Mon.)	Fall 2005 registration begins for eligible new and readmitted students.
April 29 (Fri.)	<p>► Last day of classes for spring 2005.</p> <p>► Last day for students to turn in Time Out Program (TOP) applications to the registrar's office for spring semester. (See http://registrar.colorado.edu/Support/Timeout.htm)</p>

May 9-26 (Mon.-Thurs.)	Summer 2005 Maymester session.
